The brand is named after the unique topography of their 30 acre Estate, a true bench land vineyard located on the eastern side of Napa Valley, directly below the Stags Leap District Palisades.

Partnering with Jim Barbour on the vineyard side and Winemaker Mike Smith the goal of Bench Vineyards is to make modern elegant wines that reflect their Stags Leap District vineyard location.

THE ESTATE

Planted to Cabernet Sauvignon in 1964, this site was chosen by Richard Steltzner for its unique topography at the base of the Stags Leap Palisades. Meticulous farming by Jim Barbour partnered with mature vineyard plantings provide amazing quality of fruit to work with. Gentle slope, elevation, unique soils and cool breezes from the San Pablo Bay mark this as a truly remarkable vineyard site.
